

A Spirit Life

And as we obey Him like Abraham did, we are going to enter into a place in life that is fulfilling and beautiful!

Beloved, real life is in the Spirit. The Spirit gives life.

Again, Jesus says, "Whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst, but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water, springing up to eternal life."
