Daniel never campaigned for influence in Babylon.

He was a captive in a hostile empire, serving kings who worshiped other gods. And yet he kept getting promoted. By Nebuchadnezzar. By Belshazzar. By Darius. Three regimes, one Hebrew, ever-increasing authority.

Scripture tells us why.

Daniel 6:3 “Then this Daniel distinguished himself above the governors and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king gave thought to setting him over the whole realm.”



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An excellent spirit. Daniel's work was so consistently superior that a pagan king planned to put him over the whole empire. His enemies audited his entire life and found nothing to use against him except his prayer life.

Here's the principle, and it applies directly to you: excellence earns the room. The anointing fills it. Most Kingdom leaders try to skip the first part. They want spiritual authority in spaces where they haven't yet demonstrated professional credibility. But Babylon opens doors for competence. Then your beliefs walk through with you.

So the quality of your work is a witness before you say a single word about Jesus. Your craft, your reliability, your follow-through. All of it preaches.
