

Bethel Live Debuts New CD/DVD

Bethel Live releases its all-new, full-length CD/DVD, *For The Sake Of The World*, today from Bethel Music. Recorded live at Bethel Church in Redding, Calif., the project is receiving wide critical acclaim as it delivers inspiring new worship songs led by Brian and Jenn Johnson, Jeremy Riddle, William Matthews and Steffany Frizzell-Gretzinger.
