

Christian Artist Nominations Announced for 2021 Grammys

The 2021 Grammy Award nominations are in and stand out Christian artists are in the running for prestigious recognition of the best of the music industry.

Kari Jobe, Cody Carnes and Elevation Worship were nominated for best contemporary Christian music performance/song with “The Blessing,” along with We The Kingdom’s “Holy Water.”

At the 51st Annual GMA Dove Awards in October, We The Kingdom claimed new artist of the year, and Kari Jobe’s “The Blessing” took home worship song of the year.

This year, Hillsong Young & Free’s album *All of My Best Friends* was nominated for best contemporary Christian music album, as well as *Jesus Is King* by Kanye West and *Citizen of Heaven* by Tauren Wells.
