

Don't Be Moved by Your Feelings, Be Moved by Your Faith

You are waiting for a feeling when you should be entering by faith. Then you shall feel, and then you will see. Faith is the doorway to what you are seeking.

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The immature believer says, "I don't feel; therefore, it's not real, God has left me" and so on. These are distracting lies to keep you from His presence.

The mature believer says, "I am not moved by what I feel. I believe in faith, and because I draw near, I begin to see Him, because faith is the door and the way is the blood."
