This is an act of humility of the church and the people of the land: submission to the true God and His church, which is the bride of Christ, born of God's Spirit through Jesus Christ as one with God the Father, God the Son and the Holy Ghost.

The word from God to His people is unity in the Spirit. The very force of unified prayer from the authentic church will provoke God to respond to His bride and grant her request. But she must be holy, adorned and sold out to penetrate the forces of evil in the earth and pull down answered prayer. This means God's people and the corporate church must come together as one in the Spirit, crying out to God for healing of our land. He is the answer through us. It is our hour of power, wake up!
