It will, according to the parable, end up many times more possessed and evil than before.”

This is exactly what will happen to America—unless the country turns and repents, as Cahn explains. “Evil will give way to good, falsehood to truth and the darkness to the breaking of dawn. The gods will fade into the brightness of His coming, the coming of Him who is the only Light—and who alone is God.”

Cahn delves into the rise and fall of these ancient deities, answering questions such as:

Who are the ancient gods? What are they? And is it possible that these beings, whose origins are from ancient times, are the unseen catalysts of modern culture?

Is it possible that these gods lie behind the most pivotal events, forces and movements taking place in our nation and around the world at this very moment? Are the gods at this very moment transforming our culture, our children, our lives and America itself?

What is the Dark Trinity? Is it possible that what we in the modern world take as nothing more than ancient mythology could actually possess a reality beyond our fathoming?
