

Prophetic Word: 2022 Will Bring Explosive Movement in the Kingdom

“The Lord, the LORD Almighty, called you on that day to weep and to wail, to tear out your hair and put on sackcloth. But see, there is joy and revelry, slaughtering of cattle and killing of sheep, eating of meat and drinking of wine! ‘Let us eat and drink,’ you say, ‘for tomorrow we die!’” (Isa. 22:12-13).

The issue of eating and drinking is highlighted many times in Scripture, directly relating to an attitude of the heart that is primarily concerned with satisfying the things of the flesh as opposed to the things of the Spirit and having eternal value. Paul quotes this very scripture in addressing the realities of eternal life and resurrection, as reasoning for endurance and perseverance through times of much persecution.

“If I fought wild beasts in Ephesus with no more than human hopes, what have I gained? If the dead are not raised, ‘let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die!’” (1 Cor. 15:32).
