

'The Chosen' Drops Highly Anticipated Season 2 Finale

The global phenomenon *The Chosen*—the first multi-season show about Jesus and the #1 crowdfunded media project in history—released its highly anticipated season two finale on Sunday, July 11, with a global livestream simulcast on Facebook, Youtube and *The Chosen* app.

"This season, Jesus' growing fame has brought resistance from the Romans and religious leaders, and the disciples are struggling with how to deal with it. This sets the stage for Jesus to put together the most famous sermon in history," said Dallas Jenkins, series creator, co-writer and director. "Despite the growing danger, He's determined to deliver one of the most important sermons of his life."

The eighth installment is free through *The Chosen* app, which is also available for download at the Apple or Android app stores.
