Having spent 23 minutes in hell in 1998, Bill Wiese can give an accurate description of what it's like in that awful place. And, Wiese says, there are many horrific aspects of a place he guarantees nobody ever wants to be.

"The worst part of hell is the hopelessness, knowing you'll never get out, you'll never escape and that no one will come to rescue you," Wiese says. It's real.
