

WATCH: Alice Cooper Mocks Christ in Last Night's 'Superstar' Performance

Rocker Alice Cooper slipped into the role of Herod for NBC's *Jesus Christ: Superstar!* performed live last night.

"Jesus, I am overjoyed to meet you face to face," Cooper taunted Christ, played by John Legend.

Cooper, a renowned Christian, continues with "Herod's Song," while Legend kneeled before him.
