"This documentary will engage viewers with a compelling exploration of the history of Easter. Through delving into the Bible and the Resurrection, not only Easter but the human condition may be better understood."

Filmed in Israel, Italy and at the Museum of the Bible, the documentary has a vast perspective on the history of Easter, presenting the origin of many of its traditions that have grown through the ages, ending with a presentation of the original Easter week.

The History of Easter is narrated by Matthew West, an award-winning Christian musician and actor, and incorporates narration, museum exhibits, recreated Resurrection footage and motion graphics. Museum of the Bible, Minus Red and TBN previously worked together to produce *The Truth I'm Standing On* (2020) and *The Night of the Nativity* (2020).
