These blessings flow from the Holy Spirit within us, “overflowing with the rivers of living water.”

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As Schneider points out, this is why Paul prayed in Ephesians that God would give us “a spirit of wisdom and revelation... and that we would understand the power that’s at work in our lives, which is the same power that raised Christ from the

dead.”
