**HEART ISSUE:** Don't give up on those relationships that have presented challenges. Put them in God's hands. Let His perfect peace surround you, as His Spirit guides you. Reflect on how He has intervened in your life before to mend a broken relationship.

**PRAYER FOCUS:** Father, thank You that in all my associations, You are Lord. I am a representative of Your kingdom, and the Spirit of Christ, which dwells powerfully within me, can bring peace and joy to all my relationships. Amen.
