

The Hidden Battle: Tony Merkel on Spiritual Warfare and the Fight Against Demons

Merkel was directed by the Holy Spirit to sit in a specific chair, avoiding another near a door that led to the basement. During their conversation, the man admitted the house was haunted by "seven ghosts" and later revealed he was a member of the church of Satan.

"This is what God was trying to warn me about," Merkel said. "He gets up, walks over to a bookshelf, and pulls out satanic literature, putting it on the table in front of me. He says, 'I want you to take these out of my house.'" While Merkel agreed to dispose of the books, the man shouted at him not to burn them, further intensifying the eerie atmosphere.

After leading the man in a prayer to accept Christ, Merkel noticed disturbing behavior. The man would violently shake, exhale deeply, and cling to Merkel in full-body hugs. "I've done street ministry before...and I've never seen anybody act that way after a salvation prayer," Merkel admitted. Looking back, he realized the exhalations were likely an attempt to transfer demonic entities onto him.
