Sozo deliverance seems to be an inner healing type of ministry; however, sozo deliverance ministers do not cast out demonic spirits. Although sozo deliverance can help you deal with mental strongholds, it cannot help you deal with demonic strongmen (the spirits behind the strongholds). This is because sozo is not truly deliverance. The only way to get demonic spirits out of a person is by forcing, driving and casting them out.

So, if you are seeking full deliverance from demonic

strongholds and demonic strongmen, seek the Holy Spirit for deliverance. He is the deliverer. However, if the Holy Spirit leads you to a deliverance minister, this person will be someone who casts out devils like Jesus did. {eoa}

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
