

Why Your Destiny—Not Your History—Defines You

One of the detriments of not receiving the healing of our past is that we won't trust people in the future to assist us in freedom.

You are defined by your destiny, not your history. When the thoughts cycle over through the minds of our past, we don't move up and forward toward freedom. God has set people in place to assist you. He has anointed and appointed someone to heal you and bring out your full potential. But often because of our history, we don't give these people a chance and we sabotage the relationship before they help us reach our destiny.

When we haven't been valued by people, loved unconditionally or accepted by society, it is difficult to change those fleshly emotions to receive what God wants to give us. The challenge is God uses people to give to us, and if we can't trust the people in our history, often we don't trust the people in our present that will lead us to our destiny.
