Week 4, n=246, April 7-13, 2020









How much has the COVID-19 pandemic affected the overall well-being of the people in your church?






Last week, how did online participation compare to typical (in person) Sunday attendance?





What happened with financial giving last weekend?








What is the primary way your church is serving your local community?





Who is providing you with the most help in terms of information, tools and resources to deal with this crisis?








Currently, what do you see happening with congregants' personal faith journey during this pandemic?










Based on everything you're seeing right now, how confident are you that your church will survive?








Among churches that offered an Easter service



In general, what sort of feedback, if any, did you receive from your congregation about their experience with the Easter service(s)?




Based on what you have observed, which of the following represents the most immediate need for people in your congregation?










Do you think your church will continue to provide digital options for worship services once social distancing is no longer required?






Does your church use a multiplier to help measure "attendance" for a worship service?



Average multiplier: 2.31 (base: use a multiplier)



















About how many people, if any, have reached out to your church in the past month, seeking help to cope with the current health and economic crisis?




How well equipped do you personally feel to help someone from your congregation deal with matters relating to mental or emotional health?





In the last month, have you or another church staff member preached on the topic of mental or emotional health?











Which of the following best describes how your church is participating in communion during the COVID-19 crisis?









