


#### Don't Cancel the Church Because a Christian Hurt You

"If you want to be

you must love people

hurch hurt is real. I have friends who've been in counseling for years because they were spiritually abused by pastors. I also know pastors who were treated horribly by deacons, elders or church members. I know a pastor's wife who battles clinical depression because of the way her husband was mistreated by their former church. But I also know a woman who was so hurt by a pastor that she left the faith.

Church hurt happens in all kinds of denominations and church networks. Baptists hurt each other, and so do Pentecostals; Calvinists can be cruel to each other, and so can charismatics. No flavor of church has a corner on cruelty. Regardless of our doctrinal preferences, we are all capable of wounding each other in the name of the Lord.

The devil is certainly the ultimate hater, and he loves it when Christians hurt each other. But let's not blame Satan for all the church hurt out there. The devil could go on a long vacation, and Christians would gladly do his work for him—because our sinful human nature is the root of betrayal, gossip, accusation, character assassination, angry outbursts, control, manipulation, domination and every other form of abuse.

Why is church hurt so destructive? Because it leads to bitterness, resentment and offense. If our enemy can convince us to be offended, he knows our souls will ultimately be poisoned with hate—and that we will spread that poison to others. The author of Hebrews warned us: "See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble, and by it many be defiled," (Heb. 12:15).

There are 1,001 ways Christians can offend you at church. But your job is not to count the offenses; you must forgive every time. We are called to love each other "fervently," (1 Peter 1:22), and fervent love requires forgiveness. Yet we have become the generation of outrage; we are experts at being offended, and our loveless attitude squelches what God wants us to demonstrate.

Most Christians overlook the last chapter of Romans because it's basically a long list of ancient names that are difficult to

pronounce. Paul refers to many of these people affectionately as "my beloved," "my kinsman" or "a choice man." They were not casual acquaintances. Paul carried these people in his heart. He had been in prison with some of them. He missed them so much that he wept when he thought of them.

And after mentioning these people, Paul reminds everyone to "greet one another with a holy kiss," (16:16). Paul's love for people wasn't just affectionate in a verbal sense. It was downright slobbery.

Paul began the book of Romans by telling his friends: "I long to see you..." (1:11a). Toward the end of the letter he says he looks forward to visiting them so that he can "find refreshing rest in your company," (15:32, NASB 1995). This miracle-working apostle reveals another side of himself; he's gushy, mushy

and huggable. He's the quintessential people person.

This fervent love Paul showed his friends in Romans 16 is the essence of biblical Christianity. But this passionate love wasn't limited to the Romans. He told the Philippians: "I long for you with all the affection of Christ Jesus," (Phil. 1:8). And Paul wrote to the Thessalonians: "Having so fond an affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you ... our own

lives," (1 Thess. 2:8).

Was there church hurt in the days of the early church? Of course! People are people. We are all deeply flawed and capable of abusing each other.

There's plenty of evidence that some Christians dishonored Paul, mistrusted him and even slandered him. But Paul's response was to love, forgive and hold fast to his faith. He didn't allow church hurt to infect his heart.

If you want to be spiritually mature, you must love people no matter how they have hurt you. Canceling the church isn't an option. Closing your heart and living in isolation is immature and selfish. If your love has grown cold, forgive the people who hurt you.

Ask God to remove the offense—and take the risk to love His people again.



often teach on a variety of subjects, but I believe my primary calling is to help Christians grow up and mature in Christ and really begin to enjoy the great life He has in store for them.

As a young woman, I went to church for years, but I really didn't know much about spiritual maturity. I loved God with all of my heart, but I wasn't changing—I was still as critical, judgmental and rebellious as ever. And even though I knew my life should be getting better, I was still miserable from dealing with all of the same problems.

I believe this is one of Satan's greatest strategies. If he can't keep people from hearing the gospel and accepting Christ, he will do everything he can to make sure they never grow spiritually and experience the peace and joy that's promised to them in the Bible.

You see, when we're born again, the Holy Spirit comes to live in our heart—God plants a seed of everything He is in our spirit. He instantaneously deposits inside of us everything we need to live a great life.

For instance, Galatians 5:22-23 (AMPC) says, "The fruit of the [Holy] Spirit [the work which His presence within accomplishes] is love, joy (gladness), peace, patience (an even temper, forbearance), kindness, goodness (benevolence), faithfulness, gentleness (meekness, humility), self-control....'

Did you know all of these things already exist on the inside of you? You may wonder, Well, if that's the case, then why aren't I experiencing any of it in my life?

When it comes to the maturity process, we have a part to play. Our part is to cooperate with God to cultivate and develop His character in our lives so we can grow and become more like Him. How do we do that?

It all begins by spending regular time in God's Word. Hebrews 4:12 (AMPC) says, "The Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]...."

When we spend time in God's Word, we are spending time with God. His Word changes us—it changes how we think and how we act. It changes how we see God, ourselves and the world

Romans 12:2 is a great Scripture that shows us how we grow spiritually: "Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God..." (AMPC).

God has a "good and acceptable and perfect" plan for our lives, but we must renew our minds with His Word before we can experience it.

It's important to remember that growing spiritually is a process. When I first began to read and study God's Word, I immediately saw things I needed to change. For a while, I felt guilty and condemned that I wasn't "measuring up."

However, God helped me to understand that He never shows us these things to condemn us and make us feel guilty. He convicts us of our behavior in order to help us grow and come up higher in that area.

For example, I was extremely rebellious in the early years

of my marriage. Because my father sexually abused me when I was growing up, I had developed a distrust of men. I vowed that no man would ever again push me around.

But as I learned God's Word, I saw that my behavior toward my husband, Dave, was wrong. The Lord was asking me to walk in love with Dave in my speech, attitudes and actions.

This was easier said than done! But God always gives us the grace to do what He is asking us to do. He doesn't expect us to do it all on our own.

So, little by little, by God's grace, I

began to change. The Lord transformed me from being rude, critical, harsh and rebellious into someone who has real peace, love and jov.

But it was a process—it didn't happen overnight.

Look at 2 Corinthians 3:18 (AMPC). It says we "are constantly being transfigured into His very own image in ever increasing splendor and from one degree of glory to another...."

The Lord changes us a little at a time. None of us will ever be perfect until we get to heaven, and that's OK. But as long as we're here on this earth, God desires for us to continually cooperate with Him to learn and grow.

As we do—as we continue to grow spiritually and change "from glory to glory"—we will experience the incredible peace, joy and fulfillment that only God can give us.

And we will show the world around us what God is really like.



#### Movin' In a Slow Hurry (December 1986)

grew up under the tutelage of a wonderful old Southern lady named Willie Mae McGriff. She was an intimate part of our family for over 30 years. It was she who taught me the art of being in what she called a slow hurry.

There were mornings when she arrived at our house moving slow. My mother, who was hyper and sometimes demanding, would push her a little. I remember Will Mae's delightful response: "Don't worry 'bout that, Miss B. I'll get it done. Today I'm just moving in a slow hurry."

What a great way to accomplish the important things!

It was this lesson King David learned so painfully when it came time to return the Ark of the Covenant after it had been released from captivity by the Philistines. Eager to have the ark placed in its new home atop Mr. Zion, David commandeered the first vehicle

he could find. It turned out to be an ox cart pulled by a couple of milk cows. That didn't matter to David as long as he got the job done.

While God is a God of enthusiasm (the word "enthusiasm," you may know, comes from two Greek words, entheos, meaning "in God"), man's problem is confusing genuine spiritual excitement with impetuousness. Too many of us act

like old steam locomotives—blowing off all the power in the whistle, saving little to turn the wheels.

David was not interested in means. His job, as commander, was to secure the ark on Mt. Zion as quickly as possible.

The story of what happened when David got ahead of God—and tried to do God's work using man's method—is classic. Depending on organization rather than charisma, he assigned men to hurry the process. To David, the completion of the task was far more important than the method used. The results were tragic. When the ark tilted on the cart and one of the men reached up to steady it, he was struck dead. That's heavy stuff. It was God's way of saying He is more interested in the way a thing is done than whether it is completed.

After losing one of his top men because of his haste, David slowed down. He left the ark at the house of a fellow named Obed-Edom. He returned to Jerusalem to do a little Bible study. When all else fails, read the instruction manual.

Three months later he returned for the ark. But his attitude had changed, as well as his methods. No longer was he impetuous. This time he was willing to move in a slow hurry.

How had he changed?

He had studied the Bible.

He had sought counsel from wise men.

He was determined to follow God's plan—no matter how foolish it seemed.

He communicated with his people.

He organized his men.

Finally, he moved ahead, but only six steps at a time. After each stage he stopped the procession. They took time to build an altar, offer sacrifices and celebrate before moving on another six steps and repeating the entire process. He was in a slow hurry—right on God's

schedule.

I shudder when I consider all the projects going on in the kingdom. God has a perfect way for His people to evangelize the world, to spread the gospel through the media, to raise money for building projects. Yet every place I go, following the ark up the road, I hear the sounds of the ox cart.

I wonder: Could it be that God is more interested in how we raise money than the

amount we raise?

Paul Garlington, a pastor in Rochester, New York, says folks sometimes ask what he is doing on a certain day. When he says, "Nothing," they try to move in. "You don't understand," Paul tells them, "I'm occupied that day, I'm doing Nothing."

I know a lot of people who have only two speeds-full power and off. They keep passing me in life at full speed. I envy them for their ability to get a lot done in a short period. Yet as I plod down the road like the proverbial tortoise racing the hare, I often see their burned-out ruins.

No engine, especially the human engine, is designed to run at full power constantly.

Throttle back occasionally. Stop and study. Happiness and health come when you learn to move in slow hurry.

Believe it or not, God is not depending on you—He wants you to depend on Him.

Jamie Buckingham wrote 153 columns for Charisma over 13 years, first known as "Dry Bones" but later as it's most recognized "Last Word." His singular voice was animated by a heart for Jesus baptized in the power of the Holy Spirit in 1967 at a Full Gospel Businessmen's convention. Buckingham provided a steadying force during the scandals of the 1980s, penning the seminal article on the PTL scandal, "God Is Shaking His Church" in May 1986.

#### Jesus Is My Rock and He Rolls My Blues Away

Godspell turns 50 within Jesus Movement anniversary

he delightfully oddball "Jesus rock" opera Godspell turned 50 this past summer. Although few may recall this quirky artifact of the early 1970s Jesus Movement today, most people would recognize at least one of its wonderful songs.

Written as a master's thesis project at Carnegie Melon University, this cultural relic gained a lot of traction among those who weren't necessarily open to some of the more "in-your-face" lyrics of the emerging Jesus Rock music genre. But, as the contemporary Christian rock pioneer Larry Norman would sing, "Why should the devil have all the good music?"

I was not a theologian at that time in my life. I was a 17-year-old kid in Los Angeles County right in the middle of the Jesus Movement. But, I was also a decent guitar player with my

1964 Fender Jazzmaster electric guitar and I somehow was offered a gig to play in the orchestra of a production at a large mainline church in Los Angeles.

I fell in love with several of the songs, especially the wonderful "Prepare Ye the Way of the Lord," and also "Day by Day" which became a radio hit in the summer of 1972, the year before the movie version of Godspell brought this unique version of the story of Christ to mainstream audiences.

The production itself was comical and irreverent, one very old review I found online describing it as, "the Gospel according to Matthew featuring a comedic troupe of eccentric players who team up with Jesus to teach His lessons through parables, games and tomfoolery."

Jesus was a white guy whose costume included a huge afro-style hairdo, and dressed in clown garb and shoes, yet in its obvious comedic appearance the Jesus character is both thoughtful and reflective. The actor portraying Jesus captured some of His infinite longsuffering, patience, love and peace.

Some of my fellow "Jesus freaks" at the time thought it was heretical. The rival Broadway production that season, Jesus Christ Superstar, was in many ways just that. But Godspell rang true. Jesus reached out to the marginalized, just as Matthew's Gospel shows us, and we see in this ridiculously 70's-era absurdity a

Messiah who came to do His Father's work.

Contextualization is the term we missiologists use often. To contextualize Godspell's message, it is what Paul is talking about in 1 Corinthians 9:19-23 when he says, "I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some." Whether it is musical style, dress or other culturally defined distinctions, the apostle seems quite adamant to say those things are minor; do what you need to do in order to reach others with the good news of the gospel. Which, by the way, is what the title of this musical, cast soundtrack and later the movie version, meant, Godspell, i.e., "Gospel" with a little twist on the words, seeming to note the message of how Jesus' words and actions had an effect on people touching hearts and souls in the deepest ways imaginable.

> So, was Godspell just an outlier, something to smile about as we consider other obsolete expressions of that era's culture (polyester floral shirts, bell bottoms)? The remarkable reception to this year's Jesus Revolution movie struck a powerful resonating chord in the lives of so many people. Some, like those my age, were reminded of a genuine move of the Spirit of God among an entire generation—younger followers

of God's Spirit, inspired by the movie to pray for a new and genuine revival that would reach another generation today.

Perhaps there is an inspiring takeaway possible from this goofy production that was, quite honestly, just a blip on the screen in terms of its historic importance within the turmoil of that decade. Artists and musicians often are left out of serious discussion about revival, even though frequently it will be the arts and music communities who are contributing to the wider staying power to a revival. Think of the Brownsville Revival songs that we still hum in our minds today. King Solomon ordered that the musicians and the artists would have a central role in establishing God's temple.


We probably don't need an updated version of Godspell, but we do need the younger generation to use their God-given gifts and talents for His glory!

#### **Christmas in History**

NASA astronauts broadcast from first-ever lunar orbit

ong before the days of cancel culture, three NASA astronauts spent Dec. 24, 1968, in a miraculous way, carrying out the first-ever orbit of the moon by humans and acknowledging the Creator of all in a special broadcast from space.

The Apollo 8 mission was originally intended as only a test run for a future lunar landing, but when progress on the lunar module took longer than expected, NASA adjusted its plan. The resulting moon mission was a huge success as astronauts Frank Borman. who passed Nov. 7, Jim Lovell and Bill Anders became the first to escape Earth's gravitational pull, see their home planet from space and orbit the moon-all on Christmas Eve.

From that incredible vantage point, the astronauts broadcast their report back to Earth, ending in "Merry Christmas, and God bless all of you, all of you on the good Earth," a moment that remains one of the most-watched in all of television history.



# ACCESSING THE POWER OF FASTING & TRANSFORMATION

Private discipline and public reward through fasting

hen I first wrote a book about fasting 20 years ago, I was just trying to get the word out to as many people as possible about the power, favor and breakthroughs that fasting brings. I wanted people to know that when you fast, you can experience a level of intimacy with the Lord unlike any you have ever experienced. I had no idea that this book would reach so many people around the world. I just knew in my heart and from personal experience that fasting was God's secret weapon that many in the body of Christ had yet to discover. Today, I am thrilled to see millions of Christians worldwide placing such a great emphasis on prayer and fasting and, for many, that book was just the jump start

they needed to take that next step of faith.

Looking back over our ministry and seeing all God has done through the years only deepens my resolve to challenge even more believers to use the old weapon of fasting to win the new battles. We decided to implement fasting into the yearly calendar of our church long before fasting became popular. Today, the internet is filled with doctors and specialists touting the powerful medical benefits of fasting. This generation is fighting enemies that didn't even exist 20 years ago when the original Fasting book was released. Praise God that these biblical principles are timeless and not dependent on the events that grip a generation or even a nation. Fasting works. Fasting sustains. Fasting opens doors of revelation and acceleration in every generation, in every nation under the sun.

#### A Supernatural God

I believe in a supernatural God. No wall can defy or deter the God that I serve. When you fast, you will see walls of shame, walls of regret, confusion and depression begin to fall. Walls of hurt, offense and unforgiveness—they're all going to fall. In Matthew 17:20, after the disciples had tried everything they knew and still experienced no results casting out a demon, Jesus explained this critical piece of God's plan. He shared a spiritual truth: there are some kinds of issues, addictions, rejections and even demons that can only be overcome by prayer and fasting.



Whether you are just trying to feed your family in a third-world country or serving as an executive on the New York Stock Exchange, there is more-more hope, greater purpose and breakthroughs that can only come through prayer and fasting. God loves co-laboring with His own creation. He loves using you and me to accomplish His purpose in the earth. When you fast, you partner with God. He desires to have a divine partnership with you in the area of prayer and fasting for your family, your life and His purpose for you. There are times when God requires us to take private, physical action to receive a spiritual blessing. There's a connection between private, physical sacrifice and what God releases spiritually in the Bible.

Exodus 17 tells the story of Moses holding up his hands with a staff and, as long as his hands were extended, the battle was won against the enemies of Israel. But when Moses' arms started getting weary, the battle would begin to turn as his arms would lower and Israel's enemies would start to prevail. The story tells us that there are times when what we do physically affects our circumstances. Fasting is perhaps the most powerful physical action a Christian can take to show God how sincere you are about wanting to see change. In reality, there is no war between God and Satan. Satan is not co-equal with our God.

But there is a war between angelic forces and demonic forces. And you and I get to vote on who wins! We have a vote in the battle in the heavenlies. We can affect the forces of darkness when we fast and pray.

Where there is little private discipline, there will be little public reward.

We can have influence in the unseen world by fasting.

#### **God Reveals Assignments** When We Fast

I encounter so many young believers who are desperately seeking God for their calling, their assignment. If there is one recurring theme in my life and ministry it's that fasting is the birthplace of assignments. I was 19 years old when the Lord impressed upon me to fast for three days. For a 19-year-old, this seemed so extreme. Nevertheless, the gravity of that moment was not lost on me and I went on a three-day fast. At the end of the three days, God called me to preach. It was undeniable what God was calling me to do and I knew this life-altering moment happened because I had fasted. That fast was the birthplace of my assignment. I found my mission. I found my calling. It's time to develop some of your own "extremes" when Satan is coming with such targeted opposition against you and your life. I've learned that I'm stronger with God when I am seeking Him more. When I feel weaker, I am seeking Him less.

The Bible says this about King Uzziah in 2 Chronicles 26:5: "And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him to prosper." I have found that the most dangerous period for all of us, and especially leaders, is when God is blessing us. We get complacent and stop seeking Him with all our heart. When we are weak with God, temptation is strong. When we are strong in our relationship with God, temptation is weak. That's why Jesus didn't fall for the trap when Satan came to Him in the wilderness with extreme temptations. Jesus instead defeated Satan in the wilderness with His own extremes: extreme fasting,

extreme prayer and extreme focus on the Word of God.

#### **Discipline Is Required**

Fasting breaks the monotony of the weekly schedule and your focus shifts to the things that matter most. Fasting requires the discipline of extra time and focus on Jesus, His Word and His presence. When you do that, you become a disciple, a disciplined one. When you discipline yourself like this, look out! God will raise you up because you have humbled yourself before the mighty hand of God and, in due season, He will raise you up. He will promote you and He will open doors that you once thought were walls. He will give solutions and answers where there was only confusion, silence and doubt because you will have the hand of God on your life in a dimension you've never experienced. Some will even see miracles.

In this culture of entertainment and instant gratification, it's almost unheard of to expect people to sacrifice. That word has been lost in the body of Christ. Biblical fasting has to do with being preoccupied with God and His will rather than the things of this world. When we begin to biblically fast, we increase our receptivity to the Lord's voice and to His Word. It's not easy to fast. It's not fun to fast. It requires sacrifice, but the powerful reward is worth the sacrifice because your faith will begin to explode as you fast.

doing a liquid fast for three days and then converting over to the Daniel fast. You figure out what works for you and stick with it. Have a made-up mind about fasting and purpose in your heart, "I'm going to fast and I'm going do it for the glory of God."

Time and experience with fasting make me qualified to proclaim with boldness, that if you will seek the Lord through fasting and prayer, then He will release a freshness, a sensitivity, a new desire and a tender spirit upon your life. Seek Him. Seek His face with fasting and prayer and He will reward you. It's not about the food. It's not about the recipes and it's not about legalism. It's about fasting for more of Him. If I do nothing but abstain from certain foods, I have wasted my time. I must also focus on the Word, on worship and on prayer.

#### **Private Discipline Leads** to Public Reward

Victories are not won in public, but in private. Where there is little private discipline, there will be little public reward. Whenever there is private fasting and prayer in the secret places of our life there will be public rewards! If you want a stronger relationship with God, you have to seek it. There is a secret source to our power, and it always accompanies the discipline of fasting and prayer.

Fasting is not for the strong. Fasting is

for the weak. Fasting is for the common. Fasting is for the frail and for the ordinary. Fasting is for people of all ages and all cultures who realize that they desperately need more of God in their life. Fasting is for you.

If you've never fasted before, I encourage you to begin this journey, maybe even this week. Start with one day or possibly three days. Or, if you've fasted many times, maybe go a little longer but always with this warning—consult your physician before taking on a longer fast.

I'm excited about what God will do for you on this journey if you will step up and say, "God, I want You, and I'm coming after You through prayer and fasting." You literally have nothing to lose but a few pounds if you fast and feel nothing. But you will have everything to gain when you experience the greatest breakthroughs of your life, moments that will mark you and change your trajectory forever.

#### What Should I Fast?

As I travel, the number one question people have on the topic of fasting is, "What should we fast and how long?" My response is always the same: "That's up to you." It is up to you. At my church, for over 30 years we have started every year with a 21-day fast, and it is truly the most exciting time of the year. Over one million people worldwide fast with us for 21 days in the month of January every year. Some people will fast from sun up to sundown and others will fast one meal a day. The most common is the Daniel fast, which is no meat, no bread, no sugar. It's a very healthy and powerful fast. Some people are

DISCOVERING YOUR SPIRITUAL DESTINY TO TURN HEARTS BACK TO GOD



<mark>lija</mark>h had a unique quality: he moved by the unction of the Holy Spirit. This unction empowered him to step into the spirit and pull out a prophetic mandate for a nation. Unction is a driver for Elijah prophets, and they need to build it and stir it up as they carry out the mandates of God.

#### What Is Unction?

The word unction is not a word we hear very often. Merriam-Webster defines unction as "the act of anointing as a rite of consecration or healing...spiritual fervor or the expression of such fervor." Unction appears only once in the King James Version of the Bible: "But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things," (1 John 2:20, KJV). The Greek word translated "unction" is chrisma. It means an unguent or ointment, a smearing. It also means anointing. In fact, many Bible translations use the word *anointing* instead of unction.

Chrisma comes from the Greek word chriō, which means to smear or rub with oil, to consecrate, to anoint. It is used in the Greek translation of the Isaiah 61 prophecy that Jesus read aloud in the synagogue in Nazareth, which He then declared had been fulfilled. The comparable Hebrew word for unction or anointing is māšḥâ. It refers to the holy oil used to anoint Aaron and the other priests for service in the tabernacle or temple of the Lord.

Unction is the anointing of the Holy Spirit. When the Holy Spirit abides in us, if we are in tune with His voice, He will teach us, direct us, guide us, give us words to speak, show us things to do. He causes us to walk in truth. His will be the voice when "your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, 'This is the way, walk in it,' whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left," (Isa. 30:21).

In the Driver's Seat

Unction is the direction of the Holy Spirit. It will drive you to something or away from something. It will direct your paths. But to be led by the Holy Spirit and experience His unction at work in your life, you need to have a personal relationship with the Holy Spirit.

That personal relationship fosters trust in the Lord. If you don't have that trust, when the time comes to step out in faith and do something that seems crazy or defies what your logical mind is telling you to do, you will hesitate, question, delay, or even fail to carry out your assignment. Proverbs 3:5–6 says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on

your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths." Elijah prophets need to have the Holy Spirit in the driver's seat, which is why trust is critical for them. It is hard to trust someone you don't know. That is why your time in the wilderness is so vital. You must develop an intimate relationship with the Holy Ghost.

A close relationship with the Holy Spirit also develops your sensitivity to the Spirit and to things happening in the spiritual world. This is also vital for those walking in the spirit and power of Elijah.

As prophets called to preach repentance and call people to turn their hearts back to the Lord, it is all too easy for Elijah prophets to forget who the battle is really against. Ephesians 6:12 reminds us, "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."

Unction is about being led by the Holy One and letting Him steer you in the Holy Spirit, many times we get the words He wants us to speak right on the spot. But again, for that to happen, you must have a personal relationship with the Holy Spirit. We need the boldness that comes from the Holy Spirit. The words we speak as Elijah prophets are not preconceived. They are not coming from our own personal agendas. They are coming straight from the heart of God.

That is why the experience in the wilderness is so critical. You need that time

> hidden away with the Lord. You need the time of refreshing, of spiritual growth, of feasting on and being washed by the water of the Word, of learning to hear the Spirit's voice—and developing your own voice. You need to be in that place of cutting away and dying to self to have the unction of the Holy Ghost.

# **Stumbling Blocks**

There are things that can get in the way of the unction of the Holy Spirit and hinder us from fulfilling our assignments. I call these stumbling blocks to the prophetic.

Mixing up your own opinions and views with the truth of what the Lord is saying is a big one for Elijah prophets. Remember, God's thoughts are higher than

your thoughts, and His ways are higher than your ways (Isa. 55:8-9). Never become narrow-minded or dogmatic about the revelations the Lord is giving you. If God starts speaking something new to you, be open to it. Stay tuned in to His voice, not the thoughts and inclinations of your own heart and mind.

Fear of man is another potential stumbling block to walking in the spirit and power of Elijah. Elijah could have chosen to give in to fear of Ahab and Jezebel. John the Baptist could have chosen to give in to fear of Herod and Herodias

> the right direction, accelerating you into the next season at the right time, or hitting the brakes if the situation warrants. It is also about listening to what the Holy Spirit is speaking to you. Jesus said, "When He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come" (John 16:13). The Holy Ghost is the One who will guide us, direct us and give us words of truth to speak.

In fact, when we get the unction from

or fear of the Pharisees. And the Elijah prophets of today could choose to give in to the fear of whomever the enemy sends against them. But the Word of God says that "the fear of man brings a snare" (Prov. 29:25). Fear of man is a trap, so don't fall for it. The fear of the Lord, on the other hand, is anything but a trap.

We overcome fear of man with the fear of the Lord. We overcome fear of man with faith. We overcome fear of man with love, for "perfect love casts out fear," (1 John 4:18).

Another common stumbling block is being a respecter of persons. When the apostle Peter was preaching to Cornelius' household, he said, "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality" (Acts 10:34). Other translations say that "God is no respecter of persons" (MEV). Respect of persons is often a religious spirit, causing people to try to limit their ministry to a certain denomination. Respect of persons can also be rooted in prejudice. But regardless of its source, it is a stumbling block for Elijah prophets. James 2:9 says, "But if you show partiality, you commit sin, and are convicted by the law as transgressors." To walk in the spirit and power of Elijah, you must deliver the heart of God without partiality.

Human compassion—having compassion for something God is judgingis another potential stumbling block for Elijah prophets. You cannot allow human compassion to affect your prophetic flow. Ministering correction to people you love is difficult, but you are called to obey the Spirit. You are called to walk in the Spirit. When the Holy Spirit is prompting you to speak, failing to speak out of misplaced compassion is actually unloving. Prophesying truth brings deliverance to the hearer. Don't leave someone you care about chained up in bondage to sin out of what you think is compassion. Jesus wants them to walk in freedom. Proclaim liberty to the captives.

Your time in the wilderness with the Lord will help with overcoming whatever stumbling blocks you are facing. To come against the stumbling blocks, you must first desire truth in your inward parts.

You need to desire the real truth, the truth of the Lord that reaches down all the way into the depth of your being.

#### ALLOW GOD'S HOLINESS TO EMPOWER YOU TO WALK IN YOUR CALLING!

This is the season to spread the good news of the gospel with the boldness of Elijah! As God is raising up a prophetic people who will prepare the way for His purposes in this generation, now is the time to discover how to pray earth-shaking prayers and see what a double portion life looks like. What better way to wrap up your year than with a bold and holy calling on your life?

Don't be led astray by any kind of deception, especially self-deception. It takes the mercy and power of the Holy Spirit to break through deception.

#### **Holy Spirit Freedom**

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of truth. He will give you the wisdom you need to root out any issues in your heart

that may cause you to stumble. When the Holy Spirit reveals the flaws and failings in your heart, be humble and honest with yourself rather than trying to justify your actions and attitudes. Humility and honesty are needed for healing and deliverance to occur.

The next step is to repent immediately. Delaying your response to what the Holy Spirit has shown you will only hurt you since the delay can lead to hardness of heart and even to more deception. And remember that delayed obedience is disobedience.

The last step is to rend your heart. Rending one's garments is a sign of grief or desperation that was practiced often in the Bible and is still practiced by some Jewish people today. However,

God doesn't want a grief that is only on the surface. He wants to see a change in vour heart.

You need to tear your heart away from anything and everything in your life that will be a stumbling block to walking in the spirit and power of Elijah, anything and everything that will block the flow of the Holy Ghost. If you are stuck in patterns of sin, some tearing will be required for you to be set free. But Jesus wants you living and walking in freedom. Don't stay bound up in the shackles of your sin. Deal radically with your issues—all your hang-ups and hiccups and hardness of heart—and be delivered and set free!

#### Stir It Up!

Unction comes from the Holy Spirit. There is no other way to get it. You can't manufacture it. You can't fake it. You can't buy it. You can't get it by pulling yourself up by your bootstraps. You can't get it by doing good deeds. You can't get it

> by reading about it or hearing about it or talking about it. You can't get it with might or power either.

> Unction only comes from being in a close, personal relationship with the Holy Spirit. There is no substitute for it. It starts in your wilderness time, in your waiting time. After God has purified and refined our hearts is when He begins to give us the unction. When you are bound together with the Lord, He will become your source—for everything. And that closeness, that solid relationship, that connection with the Holy Ghost is the firm foundation you need to walk in the

spirit and power of Elijah.

will stir up your passion, your zeal.


You just need to do your part to be ready.

This possibly indicates that the practice was in use at the time, even if people did not refer to them as New Year's resolutions.

Then, by the beginning of the 19th century, it was a common practice for people to make New Year's promises and resolutions for personal change and healthy practices in their lives.

One thing is for sure, whatever your experience with New Year's Resolutions, one thing is for sure, the beginning of the year is a great time for re-evaluation and personal change.

So, what if you really could see personal growth and change in your life? Would you want it? Would you be willing to do something about it? What if I told you change had nothing to do with resolution, but everything to do with your faith?

As a Life Coach, I have worked with countless clients discussing the steps to personal change. From the beginning of time humanity has sought for a way to bring about change in their lives. What if I told you that even the disciples struggled to see change in their lives as well?

There is a unique story in the Bible where the disciples came to Jesus frustrated and were questioned their ability to see a miracle. They knew the results did not come from their hand but from the hand of Almighty God, but Jesus had given them power and authority over weakness and illness. They had seen firsthand the personal changes that took place in the lives of others. But now they were stuck.

Jesus took this moment to teach them a valuable lesson.





# Understanding what healing really is, and how to steward your well-being

ou are divinely designed to heal.

The last few years have moved health and healing to the forefront of many Christian and secular conversations. The pandemic exposed many of our hearts and fears about life and death. When we examine the Scriptures through the Old and New Testaments along with the life and death and Resurrection of Jesus, we are challenged to view life and health much differently than today's world encourages.

The Scriptures speak deeply and specifically toward healing and wellness:

- » We are created in His likeness and image.
- » He knits us together in our mother's womb.
- » He knows the hairs on our heads.
- » He knows the number of our days.
- » We are called to be stewards.
- » We are told we are temples of the Holy Spirit.
- » We are called to finish our race well.

Yet, many times in the present-day American church, it seems healing and wellness health care are not embraced. My heart is to redirect our scattered focus of today back to the wisdom and guidance of our Great Physician.

#### Shifting Focus Back to Jehovah Rapha

In many ways, today's "healthcare" model has become an idol much like the golden calves of Bible times. Today's fertility gods are ObGyn's. We use potions and spells in the forms of labels, diagnoses and drugs. We often look first to man, but only as a last resort do we then turn to God.

The divine design of our bodies has indirectly led some to risk tumbling down this slippery slope. The bodies that God gave us are so incredible at help us repair and sustain themselves that many often end up taking them for granted, abusing their physical, emotional and spiritual health due to stress, poor lifestyle choices, over use—even though our bodies then bounce back and heal. However, the Lord gives us free will and it can often lead us down a trail of destruction without respecting this blessing. And when it "breaks down" we often blame God and seek man. My prayer is we can correct this perspective.

#### **The Majesty of His Creation**

My life was deeply changed while I was getting my doctorate and we performed work on human cadavers for our anatomy lab. When I saw firsthand the incredible and intricate design of

the human body, I was overwhelmed by His majesty, power and provision in our lives, specifically as it relates to our bodies and health.

Let me share a few incredible facts about the human body and God's creation...

- » Your body is made up of 50-100 trillion cells, that are all performing trillions of interactions every second, of everyday, even while you sleep.
- » Each kidney has over one million tiny filters to help clean and detox your body.

You can remove 75% of the liver and it will regrow within six weeks.

» In all of human history "man" has not been able to create one single cell from scratch, yet your body has made millions in the few minutes you have been reading this.

From these fundamental details, I hope you are reminded, inspired and empowered by how incredible the human body is that God has given each of us, created in His holy image. It is my prayer this knowledge leads to understanding that will overcome and remove fears we often have about our health, disease and symptoms while increasing our faith in Him as our Healer.

Of course, there a time and place for emergency medical intervention, but this is a small proportion of healthcare. The rest of healthcare falls into the category of lifestyle, wellness

and stewardship, yet many of us do not assume that responsibility and instead we hand it over to today's modern idol of medicine.

Here are a few additional startling statistics that may surprise you:

- » In the USA, the 3rd leading cause of death, after heart disease and cancer, is medical care itself.
- » The USA is ranked 33rd in longevity in the world.

- » Americans are only 5% of the global population, yet we consume a majority of the prescription drugs.
- » Americans have one of the worst infant and maternal mortality rates in the industrialized world.
- » Research has shown that both heart disease and cancer are significantly related to our lifestyles and not genetics.

As believers in Christ, what are we to do with this information? What does being a good steward of our health look like? In many ways, our poor stewardship has been that slippery slope of cultural influence in over four hours a day on social media, we are more sedentary than ever, we are more stressed than ever, we often eat more processed and unhealthy food, many people are taking multiple prescription drugs daily. And yet we don't even consider whether any of this is in alignment with God's plans for our lives or not.

In most of today's studies, people are just as sick and stressed inside the church as outside the church something definitely is not adding up. We have been called to be a set apart people, our lives ought to bear that fruit.

### Here's How to Engage, Steward Your Health

Just as we are called to know the Word of God so it is written on our hearts, and we need to spend time with the Word of God and the Lord Himself to know His heart and ways, the same is true with our health. Many of us simply have not invested the time learning how to properly care for the bodies God gave us.

We are often too caught up living like the rest of the world, burning the candle at both ends, living on coffee

These are nearly the last words of the Holy Scriptures. They are Jesus' words to the world. A final call. An opportunity to drink the living water, to taste of His goodness forever.

While we have talked a lot about caring for the bodies God has given us, make no mistake, we will all face the throne of judgment.

Don't settle for the things of this world. Call on the Lord. He will answer.


#### **Take Heart**

Most Christians don't know that Christmas was set on December 25, the ancient Roman Winter Solstice date, to displace a Pagan holiday celebrating the birth of a pagan false "Seed of Woman" god. The Bible does not tell us when Jesus was born. However, the search for His birthdate can begin with strong scriptural evidence about the year of His birth.

We know from Luke 3:23 that Jesus was about 30 when He began His ministry. The prophet Daniel tells us the year of Christ's anointing would come 69 7's, or 483 years, after the decree which sent Ezra to Jerusalem in 458 BC. (Daniel 9:25) Doing the math, and remembering that there is no year "0", Daniel's prophecy says Jesus would begin His ministry in 26 A.D. This year is backed up by two dates from Scripture. John the Baptist began his ministry in the 15th year of Tiberius, 25 AD, (Luke 3:1) and Jesus cleared the Temple the first

time 46 years after Herod began renovating it (John 2:20) in 20 BC (According to Josephus), or 27 AD. Thus, many Bible scholars believe that 26 AD is the year Jesus began his ministry. If He was 30 years old, remembering again that there is no year "0", He would have been born in 5 BC.

Jesus would have been born either in the spring or fall of the year according to the Scripture surrounding the birth of John the Baptist. John's father, Zechariah, was a member of the priestly order of Abijah (Luke 1:5) which, according to rabbinical sources, ministered at the Temple in May and November. The Angel Gabriel appeared to Zechariah in the Temple, and Zechariah would have gone home and probably conceived John the Baptist in June or December, who would have been born 9 months later in March or September. We know from Scripture that John the Baptist was six months older than Jesus (Luke 1:26) so Jesus would have been born in September or March of 5 BC.

To find the exact time of year we look to Astronomy and history. We know that there was a star which appeared when Jesus was born and that Magi from the East, possibly following the prophetic teachings of Daniel the Magi (Daniel 2:48), came looking for Him (Mathew 2:1,2). The Chinese also saw the Star, identifying it as a Nova which appeared in the spring of 5 BC and burned for 70 days. Based on the 5 BC springtime appearance of the Star of Bethlehem, John the Baptist was conceived in December of 7 BC, Jesus was conceived in June of 6 BC, John the Baptist was born in September of 6 BC, and Jesus was born in March of 5 BC.

King Herod, the tyrannical ruler of Judea, had interviewed the Magi when they arrived in Jerusalem. According to our research, described in our book The Stars of His Coming, (available at for a free download at (https://bit.ly/StarBook) there were signs in the Sun, Moon, and Stars surrounding the birth of Jesus beginning with Zechariah in 7 BC. The Magi would have testified to the same date. and for that reason Herod ordered all of the Children under 2 years old in Bethlehem to be killed. Josephus tells us that there was a Lunar Eclipse on Passover and that Herold died later that year. This Lunar Eclipse, or Blood Moon, occurred on March 23, 5 BC, concurrent with the Star of Bethlehem.

Scholars have shown that the Passover and the Solstices and Equinoxes were associated with Christ's birth by early Church Fathers, including Clement of Alexandria, Julius Africanus, Hippolytus of Rome, and the author of De Pascha. Some believe that Christ was born on the Passover, while others believe He was conceived on the Passover and born nine months later on the Winter Solstice. The old Roman Solstice date, December 25, ultimately was selected by the Church to replace the pagan holiday, but strong support for the birth of Jesus on Passover remains. Hippolytus stated that the "Genesis", which has been translated as "Birth" or "Conception",

of Christ occurred during a Lunar Eclipse on April 2, 2 BC. Of course the actual date of the Lunar Eclipse was 5 BC, but there is one more piece of evidence to suggest that Jesus was born on March 23 5BC, on Passover.

We find it in Revelation 12:1-2, which describes a sign in the Heavens, a woman clothed in the Sun with the Moon at her feet, at the moment of Christ's birth. The woman clothed in the Sun is the Zodiacal constellation Virgo (The Virgin), which promises that God will send a savior through Virgin birth. Astronomical research shows that the Blood Moon of March 23, 5 BC occurred while the Moon was in the feet of Virgo. Thus, Revelation 12:1-2 presents us with a picture of the night sky when Jesus was born, and that night was March 23, 5 BC.

Of course we know that the whole world will continue to celebrate the birthday of Jesus on December 25. In its way, it is fitting to celebrate the Advent on the old Roman Winter Solstice, when it all began with the conception of John the Baptist around the Winter Solstice of 7 BC and signs in the Sun, Moon, and Stars began to appear. So on the Ancient Roman Winter Solstice date of December 25, you're really celebrating the beginning of the "Signs in the Sun, Moon, and Stars" in 7BC which led to Christ's birth on Passover, March 23, 5 BC.

Merry Christmas anyway!

Birthing revival, growing closer to the Holy Spirit

person is never the same after being one among thousands of gathered people who suddenly sink to their knees in unison under the weight of the glory of His tangibly manifested presence.

When the very air in the room becomes a cloud saturated with His glory, an inexplicable weightiness—first in the stomach and then in the shoulders—makes it hard to stand without bowing while holding on to something. Before long, everyone in the room is kneeling, most with their faces pressed to the ground.

Here, in these tender moments when God is revealing His holiness in such an evident way, it becomes clear that He loves us so much that He wants to share the beauty of His holiness with us—for eternity.

The answer to the age-old question of who we are and whose we are becomes crystal-clear as the light of truth shatters the lies of darkness.

Then, when His majesty is revealed beyond human containment, the sounds of individuals sobbing unify into gut-level cry that sounds like a corporate mother giving birth.

Microcosms of the fulfillment of Philippians 2:10, when every knee on earth will bow to Jesus Christ and confess Him as Lord, sometimes occur during worship and ministry in gatherings of believers. Modern-day examples of times

when He manifested His presence in one location for extended periods time are the Brownsville Revival and the Toronto Blessing in the 90s.

#### The Unique Role of Every Spirit-Filled Believer

Quotes from Smith Wigglesworth and Jonathan Edwards provide insight into revival being perpetual and its fulfillment being dependent upon every believer being in the fullness of His Spirit, understanding his or her unique and God-appointed role.

"The revival of God's church continues, but it won't be complete until every Spirit-filled believer understands his or her unique role in its fulfillment," said Wigglesworth, a British evangelist and faith healer who was important in the early history of Pentecostalism.

"Revival is not about getting you back to year one; revival is to get you forward to where God appoints you to be in all the fullness of his Spirit," said Edwards, an American revivalist preacher and theologian.

From the chronicles of history. Wigglesworth and Edwards are still calling forth every believer to be constantly moving forward toward the fullness of Holy Spirit as they are fulfilling their unique role in ongoing revival.

Enduring and fruitful revival perpetuates forward motion. His priorities become our priorities. We are His sheep and as His sheep, we know His voice. Repentance from sin is more than a onetime action or lifestyle shift. On the one hand, it is a relational and synchronic flow in the Holy Spirit. On the other hand, it is a battle-readiness partnership with Holy Spirit and fellow believers to conquer darkness with the light of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

A good analogy of living in sync with the Holy Spirit is found in a quote from Holocaust survivor and evangelist Corrie Ten Boom: "If a bird is flying for pleasure, it flies with the wind, but if it meets danger, it turns and faces the wind, in order that it may rise higher."

#### **Hunger for Revival**

Communion with God is the life force of every believer. God is always present and those who are paying attention will recognize many of the ways He reveals Himself.

There are times, however, when people

begin to unite in a desperate cry of, "We need You, God!"

Among the many indicators that we are in a time such as this are extended prayer meetings on campuses and in public spaces, the exponential multiplication of people responding to altar calls for repentance, numerous reports of thousands of Muslims believing on Jesus after He comes to them in their dreams and large cross-sections of people gathering for prayer.

Speaking about the deepening cry of people today, Lindell Cooley recently said in a video post, "There is prayer for it. There is a hunger from people... They need something from God like never before."

Cooley was the worship leader at the Brownsville Revival, which lasted five years, and he is now the senior pastor of Grace Church Nashville.

#### The Coming Together of the Word and the Spirit

Many contemporary leaders in the church today are united in the belief that the greatest harvest of souls the world has ever seen is in its beginning stages. It has been given a variety of names: the Great Harvest, the End-Time Harvest, the Billion-Souls Harvest and others.

At the end of his life, Wigglesworth said the biggest move of God that the world has ever seen will occur when there is a coming together of those who emphasize His Word and those who emphasize His Spirit.

"When the new church phase is on the wane, there will be evidence in the churches of something that has not been seen before: a coming together of those with an emphasis on the Word and those with an emphasis on the Spirit.'

'When the Word and the Spirit come together, there will be the biggest move of the Holy Spirit that nations, and indeed, the world have ever seen," he said.

God revealing Himself through miracles that confirm the preaching of His Word, for example, expresses His love and testifies of the truth of the gospel.

"The purpose of signs and wonders is to be a vehicle of getting love to a generation," said Jarame Nelson, founder of Elisha Revolution.

Nelson and his team have reportedly

seen over one million people saved and many miracles, including miraculous healings, in Pakistan, Zimbabwe, Malawi and the Philippines this year.

Speaking of the increase in faith when prophetic insight ignites prayer for healing, J.D. King, a pastor at Revive Church in Kansas City, Missouri, told to effective leadership is getting under people and pushing them up.

"My effectiveness is not based on my performance or on my preaching, but on how many people I train and release to surpass me," he explained. "Just as Elijah gave his double-portion mantle to Elisha, we must stop being insecure of unimaginable power—is being created that will quickly and explosively destroy spiritual darkness with the light of Jesus Christ.

Apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers recently converged for panel discussions and speaker sessions in Nashville for the Fusion Conference, which was hosted by Orbis Ministries.

"At Fusion, we set out to 'fuse together' gifts which many may not think of as related. In this case, these gifts were prophecy and miracles," explains Fish. "The idea is that prophecy can catalyze miracles (Elijah prophesying a drought), and miracles often provoke prophecy (as when Mary prophesied the Magnificat)."

He said that even though they were specifically seeking to explore nonhealing miracles at the conference that brought together nearly 1,200 people, they had many healings, including miraculous healings. "Based on feedback we have received, many are reporting higher and more fluent levels of prophetic ministry through their lives, and the same with miracles."

On the Launchpad

In this time of deep travail for breakthrough, God is calling us to be reconciled to Him and to one another. The path from fission to fusion in our own lives may seem daunting, but Jesus' redemptive power will propel us to victory that releases great healing and power if we are led by Him through what may seem like the greatest challenge of our lives. "For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now. Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body," (Rom. 8:22-23). ◀

"The confidence that comes from ministering healing through prophetic guidance can be likened to holding a signed and endorsed check," he explained. "It's a promise waiting to be realized, just waiting for you to cash it in and access guaranteed results."

#### Mentoring and Making Room

At times, missionaries and evangelists who have moved powerfully in miracles overseas find that room is not made for them to minister alongside others in the church when they return to the U.S.

"After speaking and experiencing healing and miracles in a variety of countries with over 100,000 coming into the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ, I found my opportunities to serve in local churches limited to greeting visitors at the door for many years," said Melonie Janet Mangum, the transformation director for Aglow International and CEO of Partners for Transformation.

Lee Grady, founder of Bold Venture, told Charisma that he believes the secret about how successful our disciples will be. We should cheer them on when they excel beyond our capacity."

Stacy Campbell, founder of the Canadian Prophetic Council, said she has a passion to teach believers to know how to hear the voice of God through proper teaching and strong values.

"People cannot mature when they are in structures that do not allow the five-fold ministry to operate," said the founder of a mentorship program called Shiloh Company.

#### Overwhelming Breakthrough

Ken Fish, of Orbis Ministries, said he believes that we are on the cusp of an explosive breakthrough. The evangelist who studied to be a physicist earlier in his life said that it has long been said that what is seen in the physical world reflects what is happening in the spiritual world.

Drawing from this widely-held insight he said he believes that the division (fission) we see in the world today is producing such extreme pressure and elevated temperature that the energy for fusion—and the subsequent release

#### Learning to Hear God's Voice

illions have experienced the power of the Holy Spirit since the Day of Pentecost, when tongues of fire rested on those in the Upper Room and the disciples began to speak in a heavenly prayer language that made onlookers think they were drunk in the morning. In his sermon in Acts 2, Peter said they were witnessing what Joel prophesied: the Spirit of God was being poured out on all flesh, and the sons and daughters of Israel were prophesying. But there was more to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit than just what people saw and heard. A power caused 3,000 to believe that day and begin a movement that spread worldwide and continues today.

The Roman Empire tried to crush that odd Jewish sect as it had quashed many others before it. But they were unsuccessful.

The Roman Empire is gone, replaced by the Christian church, which exorcised the paganism of the Romans and the Greeks before them. Today, Christianity is the dominant religion in both Italy and Greece. While the Spirit's power seemed to ebb and flow and even go underground for generations, the Holy Spirit has been at work throughout history and has made Himself evident in our generation.

God wants nothing more than to pour out His Spirit on our sons and daughters, no matter how much it seems evil is increasing around us. Today's world is not that unlike the pagan world of biblical times. Babies were sacrificed to Molech in

places such as Caesarea Philippi, a region Jesus often visited and the site where He asked His disciples, "Who do you say that I am?"

Sexual perversion and temple prostitution were common in the known world, even in pious Israel. And if contending with pagans weren't bad enough, the religious people of the day persecuted the early believers. It reminds me of Christian denominations today that not only deny the gifts and manifestations of the Holy Spirit but hound out of their midst anyone who dares to believe or teach about them.

And today, with the advance of the Left and a one-world government, it seems we are racing toward the end of time. It's enough to discourage even the strongest believer. But it's not about us. We had no choice but to be born at this time. We don't control world events. All we can do is trust in God, believe His Word and experience the amazing power of His Spirit, which not only will help us stand up to and get through all this evil but also will help us experience joy and peace in the midst of trials, as the apostle Paul did.

Just before his execution, Paul wrote these timeless words: "For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, and I have kept the faith. From now on a crown of righteousness is laid up for me," (2 Tim. 4:6-8). Paul encourages us that this crown of righteousness is not just for him "but also to all who have loved His appearing." That is you and me.






